TITLE OF POSITION:

U.S. Army Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps Army Instructor, pending U.S. Army Approval

QUALIFICATIONS:

Army Personnel Non-retirees

- Minimum rank of SSG
- 10 years of cumulative service
- Honorable Discharge
- For actively serving ARNG and USAR:
 - 10 years of cumulative service
 - Letter of recommendation from their commander
 - Ranks: SSG-CSM/CPT-COL/WO1-CW5

Army Personnel Retirees

- Must be a Retired Army Officer/Warrant officer or Non-Commissioned Officer
- Must not be retired more than 3 years
- Must receive Instructor Certification from U.S. Army Cadet Command
- Noncommissioned Officers must be retired from the Army in the grades of E-6 through E-9
- Officers must be retired from the Army in the grades of W-1 through W-5 or O-3 through O-6.

If applying as the Senior Army Instructor a Bachelor's degree is required

If applying for the Army Instructor, an Associate's degree is preferred but not required

SALARY:

- Minimum of present DOD pay scale for Pay Grade. Shared by Retirement Pay Division, the Army, and the host school system.
- Minimum Instructor Pay (MIP) is Calculated based on retired rank within the Defense Finance Accounting Service (DFAS) Retired System.
- Minimum Instructor Pay (MIP) will be calculated after favorable CNACI and hire packet is received. This is an 11-month contract.
