## Mr. Goldworthy's 8<sup>th</sup> Grade STEAM Class Teaches Miss Baranowski's 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Class

Mr. Goldworthy's 8th grade STEAM class used the new lasers in the middle school to cut out wood pieces and build hydraulic lifts. In a hydraulic system, pressure - applied to a contained fluid at any point - then transmitted evenly among the other side to lift or pull something.

The 8th graders then built their hydraulic lifts, disassembled them, and wrote up instructions for my younger students to build. They created an awesome presentation to teach my 5<sup>th</sup> grade students all about hydraulics. With the help of their 8th grade mentor, the 5<sup>th</sup> grade students built their hydraulic lifts.

The teamwork, troubleshooting, and success of this project was incredible.
